



West TN Delta Network Grant

- 3 year, \$900,000 a year grant
- Paris & Henry County Healthcare Foundation receives ٠ \$245,000 each year plus a percentage of carry over funds from prior year if there are any left.
- Year 2 funding is \$321,114 ٠
- Currently the grant funds 4.5 FTEs that are dedicated to ٠ providing improved care to patients who are underserved, have chronic health conditions, and are readmit risks, which in turn saves the organization money.

Grow Well TN

serves the 20 rural West TN Counties and focuses on programs to address needs identified by providers and residents of the region including school-based health services to proactively prevent obesity and address behavioral health among at-risk children, care coordination, chronic disease self-management, access to affordable medicines, access to medical specialists and transportation assistance. The target population for Grow Well TN is adults and children in rural communities throughout the region who are at risk for obesity or those who have chronic conditions such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease and cancer.
