Do You Know Your Benefits Regarding Ambulance Transportation?

If you are in need of Ambulance Transportation, it is important that you know what your benefit plan will cover and what you will be required to pay for out-of-pocket.

Most government payers such as Medicare, TennCare, and Medicaid as well as some Commercial Insurances will only pay for your transport to the closest facility that is willing and able to provide the level of service you require.

Typically, those closest are Jackson Hospitals, Clarksville Hospital, and Paducah Hospitals, depending on your specific health needs.

If you choose a facility beyond the closest hospital, you will be asked to pay for the difference in mileage. The following are some estimates for your out-of-pocket costs for transport:

*Nashville Hospitals - \$1,200 +/-

*Memphis Hospitals - \$1,500 +/-

If the ambulance company serving you believes that your insurance won't pay for non-emergency transports, you will be asked to sign an Advance Beneficiary Notice (ABN).
