   Alcohol Impaired Driving Deaths (38%), and Poor Mental Health Days (5.7).
- Percent of People Who Regard Themselves in Poor or Fair Health 24%
- Teen Births are more then Double the National Average at 39 per 1,000 females.

- Long Commutes at 20% for Henry Countians = Good Jobs Not Located Close to Home.





